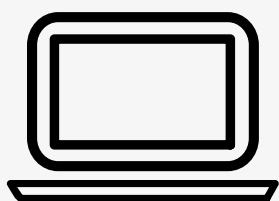
Guide to Maintaining SLiCE Student Organization Recognition

## UPDATE MEMBERSHIP MATERIAL



1. Review your organization's mission, meeting time, financial commitments, etc.
2. Roster of at least 3 members and their colostate email addresses. Remove members that are no longer affiliated or active.
3. Advisor's contact information.
4. Organization's constitution. A sample constitution is available at [rso.colostate.edu](http://rso.colostate.edu).

## ONLINE OFFICER ORIENTATION

Your president and financial officer must each complete the training and pass a quiz. There is a quiz at the end and each officer must pass with an 80%.

## START A RE-REGISTRATION FORM



1. Log on to RamLink with your eID
2. Click the rubik's cube
3. Select MANAGE
4. Officers will see all their organizations
5. Click the org then select Re-Register button

\*If a gray "Not Available" is seen, the registration window is closed.

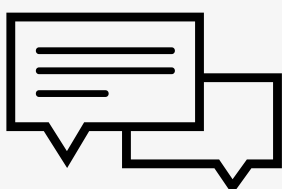
